

# REQUIREMENTS TO SELL PUPPIES AT THE FLEAMARKET MOBILE

- 1. No dog shall be sold or given away unless the dog is at least 9 weeks old.
- 2. The buyer is provided with the original State of Alabama Small Animal Health Certificate and negative fecal examination report signed by a licensed veterinarian.
- 3. Each dog must be micro-chipped, and buyer is provided with documentation of such.
- 4. A sign must be conspicuously displayed at each vendor location stating these requirements. The print on the sign shall not be less than 2 inches in height.

(e) No vendor shall offer a dog(s) for sale or gift or other transfer of owner or from any pet store or swap meet, unless there is conspicuously displayed a vendor location a sign which reads as follows:

#### ATTENTION

No dog shall be sold or given away unless the dog is at least 9 WEEKS OLD

### AND

the buyer is provided with:

the original State of Alabama Small Animal Health Certificate

#### AND

a negative fecal examination report by a licensed veterinarian

#### AND

a document showing that the dog is micro-chipped

- ALL vendors must have a valid I.D. when dealing/handling/selling ANY animal in the City of Mobile. They must present this I.D. to Animal Control Officers when requested.
- ALL cats and dogs 3 months or older must have a rables inoculation. The certificate must be available to the Animal Control Officer should it be requested.
- must be 6 weeks of age or older if being sold or ALL kittens given to the public.
- ALL animals must be healthy ie; no missing hair, mange, lice, ringworm, fungus, worms, ticks, runny eyes, runny nose. Absolutely NO sick animals on the premises.
- ALL animals must have a healthy appearance ie; mouth, gums, and tongue will
- ALL dogs and cats coats must be clean, not emitting an offensive odor, no matted hair.
- ALL animals must be on a leash, caged, kenneled, or confined AT ALL TIMES. The animals are NOT allowed to roam or run loose.
- ALL kennels/cages must have some type of bedding such as newspaper, cedar chips, wee wee pads, newspaper, towels, etc.
- ALL kennels/cages must be well and thoroughly ventilated.
- ALL kennels/cages must be kept clean of feces and urine.
- ALL kennels/cages must be of sufficient size so the animals are able to move around freely, stand comfortably, and be able to turn around. If more than one animal is in a kennel/cage they must have enough room to lie down without touching other animals in same cage/kennel.
- ALL animals that are confined to a kennel/cage must have access to water AT ALL TIMES. Hanging water bottles or bowls of water must be present at all
- ANY animal that may become sick or ill must be removed immediately from view or display to the public.
- NO animal shall be tied or left in the sun or the rain. Shelter MUST be provided at all times.
- Animals may not be left inside any vehicle unsupervised during extremely hot/warm weather. Animals are not to be left on the backs of trucks/trailers.
- No animals having contagious or dangerous diseases are allowed or to be sold to the general public.
